

ASHER'S MURDER TRIAL IS PARADOX

Philadelphia, Dec. 13.—When James L. Asher, the "Lone Wolf" prohibition agent, is brought to trial in the Federal District Court early in January in connection with the death of Peter Yancauskas, a saloonkeeper, he will be defended by the United States District Attorney and prosecuted by the District Attornel of Philadelphia County.

That this paradoxical situation will be an actual fact was made plain to-day when Assistant District Attorney Warren C. Graham announced that he had been appointed to prosecute Asher and that he intended to leave no stone unturned in his effort to convict him.
