

ACQUITTED OF HOMICIDE CHICAGO, Dec. 23.—James L. Asher, a prohibition agent, known as the "lone wolf," was acquitted by a jury tonight on charges of second degree murder and manslaughter in connection with the death of Peter Yancauska, a saloon keeper. The state contended that Asher had kicked Yancauska in the stomach in a raid, which later caused his death.
