

Prohibition Officer Acquitted in Murder Of Saloonkeeper

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 23.—James L. Asher, prohibition agent, known as the "Lone Wolf," was acquitted by a jury in the Federal district court tonight of charges of second degree murder and manslaughter in connection with the death of Peter Yancauskas, a saloonkeeper. The jury returned a verdict of not guilty after deliberating about five hours.
