

## TELLS OF BRIBERY IN U. S. TRIAL

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 19.—That two federal agents attempted to bribe him was the sensational evidence given here today by Irvin W. Jenkins, who testified for the commonwealth in the third day of the trial of James L. Asher, federal prohibition agent, known as the "lone wolf" for the murder of Peter Yancauska, a saloonkeeper.

Jenkins is the only witness, according to the commonwealth to the beating which Asher is alleged to have administered to Yancauska in a raid on his saloon April 23, 1923, and which, it is said, resulted in Yancauska's death July 16.
