James L. Asher, prohibition agent known as the “Lone Wolf” was acquitted by a jury in the federal district court tonight of charges of second-degree murder and manslaughter in connection with the death of Peter Yancauskas, a saloon keeper. The jury returned a verdict of not guilty after deliberating about five hours.
