

## Prohibition Agent Asks To Be Tried in Federal Court on Murder Charge

PHILADELPHIA, Sept. 11.—James
L. Asher, prohibition agent indicted
on a charge of murder, today asked
that the case be tried in the Federal
District Court here instead of in the
county courts. His counsel is United
States District Attorney Coles.

Asher is alleged to have struck Peter Yancauskas, a saloonkeeper, during a raid at Tenth and Winter streets, April 17, causing his death. The agent said he struck to defend himself. If Asher's request is granted it will be the first time here when a United States district attorney has appeared as consul for a man charged with a crime, and county officers appeared in the role of prosecutors in a Federal Court.
